### A. Unity Pole Update

- Elsie brought up the Peace pole to the DE&I committee, they are interested in learning more
  - Looking to possibly put on Town Hall property compared to School property
- Based on Jacey's prior meeting, she believes that the Town Manager wouldn't want it on town property
- Steve Fortenbach and James Demetriades have voiced support for a Pride project
  - The focus is about the town initiative instead of school-LGBTQ+ people in Cromwell aren't only youth
  - Could be more about intersectionality instead just LGBTQ+
- Maybe think about 5 locations (4 schools and Town Hall) for the Crosswalk
- Crosswalk possibility for schools and also possibly in front of Town Hall
  - Focus on pedestrian parking lot
- Elsie is thinking this would be February to pitch
  - Lana agrees that we should plan ahead
  - o It gives more time to get more approval from the new board
- Lana also researched that the poles in town are private property
- We should have 1 or more than 1 joint meeting to focus on messaging and planning
- Jacey also mentioned the strength of her network to bring people to help support for initiatives once defined
- Even local outreach with media could help support
- Committees should hang tight until end of October/November

#### Timeline:

- o September: Create Subcommittees within DEI and LGBTQ
- o October: Aigne, Elsie, Jacey schedule November joint meetings
- o November: joint subcommittee meetings begin
- o Town Council meeting in February

- Let's do something to get kids involved
- Lana saw a pride pancake event where they had rainbow pancake dinner
  - Per Thomas, we may have to think about food licensing
- Recommendation to participate in Trick or Trunk
  - o ECS/WIS PTO runs the event and they have a date on the calendar
- Kate/Thomas has been working on workshops that we could
  - o Youth Services was thinking of running for ABC Center and Q Plus
  - o If Youth Services runs then, we can endorse it
- We can then put out a donation box for our committee
- Jacey doesn't have time to run it, but Thomas may have capacity if the topic fits
- Kate would look into recording her prior session she ran for CMS
- Lana will call Garden Dreams and Fair Weather Acre to get
- Thomas recommended doing possibly a contest
  - Jacey recommended an optional contest



- Set up special meeting in two weeks to review
- Kate thinks the Trick or Trunk is a good opportunity
  - o Thomas thinks that this is a really strong event option
- Committee agrees to go to Trick or Trunk
- Kate to talk to Katie about when they are finding vendors
- Plan to launch Facebook page prior to Trick or Trunk
